USB 5V in For Power

3.5mm for analogue audio input

Make sure each 3.5mm audio output is connected with a transmitter, as shown on the left

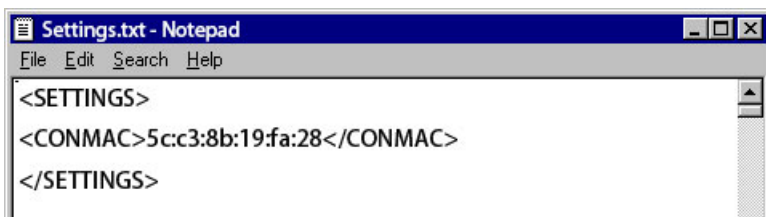
- Matching & Firmware

Each Bluetooth transmitter is dedicated to connect the targeted demo item instead of any other device (e.g. a shopper's smartphone), the demo item's Bluetooth MAC address is burned into the firmware. To update the firmware with new demo item, just replace the MAC address in the script file as below, and insert this text based file into a blank USB drive, insert this USB drive to update for 2 seconds (then pull it off to finish).

Notes: this text file name must be settings.txt, any modification will make the firmware update fail.

- Reminder Tones

When the power is connected, there will be a reminder tone "Bluetooth connected" to confirm the connection, then the Bluetooth indicator LED on the demo item becomes constantly lighted.

When the power is disconnected, there will be a reminder tone "Bluetooth Disconnected" to confirm the disconnection, then the Bluetooth indicator LED on the demo item becomes blinking.
